

# Evert Tennis Academy

## COVID-19 Response Full Time Program 2020 - 2021

### Plan Overview

Evert Tennis Academy will resume the full-time program on August 24, 2020. In preparation of this and in response to the COVID-19 global pandemic, Evert Tennis Academy has collaborated with John's Hopkins All Children's Hospital in Bradenton, Florida to establish appropriate safety measures, protocols and other preventative measures to be implemented across campus.

This plan aims to prevent COVID-19 at Evert Tennis Academy and to create a safe and healthy environment for all customers and employees. Federal, State and Local recommendations and guidelines served as guiding principles in establishment of protocols and plans.

This plan will continue to be reviewed and amended in real time as new information, guidelines and recommendations are provided at the Federal, State and Local levels of government.

### Compliance with Guidance & Mandates

Evert Tennis Academy intends to comply and adhere with all Federal, State and Local mandates and recommendations that are intended to slow the spread of COVID-19. The team at Evert Tennis Academy is prepared to continually review and adjust plans as mandates and recommendations are updated.

### Health & Safety Procedures

Outlined below are measures that are in place to help prevent COVID-19 at Evert Tennis Academy.

#### Social Distancing

Evert Tennis Academy personnel, players and any campus visitors will be required to comply with all social distancing guidelines in effect at the time of participation. The social distancing guidelines will be in accordance with the then- current Federal, state and local recommendations.

**Social distancing guidelines will be implemented throughout Evert Tennis Academy campus.**

- Evert Tennis Academy staff will be present across campus to enforce the social distancing rules
- Social distancing 6 foot markers will be placed in certain areas on campus where lines are formed and Evert Tennis Academy personnel, players, and other campus visitors are required to comply with said markers
- Common space areas on campus will have limited amounts of furniture in place preventing large group gatherings
- The cafeteria will have reduced seating capacity and tables set up to ensure social distancing
- Transportation vehicles will operate at reduced seating capacity and will have individuals sit every other seat as much as possible.
- Group sizing for training will be limited to prevent situations of crowding and impediment of space and will be conducted outdoors when practical
- Family members of players and other campus visitors will have limited campus access, primarily restricted to outside common areas

## **Cleaning & Sanitation Procedures**

To minimize transfer of COVID-19 at Evert Tennis Academy, enhanced cleaning and sanitation methods will be employed to reduce risk to staff and players.

### **Some key elements of the cleaning and sanitation plan are noted below:**

- Cleaning methods will follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidance and recommendations
- Frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of common area spaces and commonly used surfaces will be increased as compared to standard operating procedures. This includes major touch points such as door handles, stair rails, vending machines, elevator buttons, light switches, desks, etc.
- Cleaning and disinfecting of all shared training equipment and other items after use by players will occur immediately after use
- Players will be required to wash and/or sanitize their hands prior to the start of each programming session and immediately after the session
- Touchless dispensers containing hand sanitizer with an alcohol content of 60% or greater have been placed in highly trafficked areas around campus
- Handshaking and “high fiving” will be prohibited
- Educational materials focused on hand washing and sanitation are placed throughout campus to emphasize required practices

## **Cafeteria**

- All food will be served by cafeteria staff and not traditional self-service buffet style
- All utensils will be pre-wrapped and disposable
- Reduced seating capacity and table set up to ensure social distancing
- Outdoor eating at picnic tables will be encouraged.
- For evening meals only, players may participate in curbside food delivery as long as the procedures in place are strictly adhered to.

### **Below are additional measures that will be in place:**

- Hand sanitation dispensers are installed at the cafeteria and all players will be required to utilize prior to entering the cafeteria.
- Food lines will have social distancing markings in place
- Chairs and tables will be cleaned and disinfected wiped down after each use
- Additional supervision to oversee and ensure all practices are in place and being followed.
- Facial coverings to be worn by players and employees while inside (if not eating)

## **Transportation**

Transportation for players both to/from Evert Tennis Academy will have the below protocols in place.

- Players will utilize hand sanitizer upon entry of any Evert Tennis Academy vehicle. Assigned driver will be responsible for providing sanitizer to players.
- Seating for players will be spaced out to ensure one camper to every two seats as much as possible.
- Facial coverings are to be worn by all individuals
- After conclusion of each trip the vehicles will be fully disinfected

## **Evert Tennis Academy Employee Screening**

Upon entering campus, all employees are put through a health screening via a verbal assessment as recommended by the CDC. Daily Temperature checks are in place. Employees have been directed to wear facial coverings while inside campus buildings, or when interacting with players within 6 feet of player until otherwise directed by the CDC.

Any employee that has been diagnosed or has a household contact that has been diagnosed with COVID-19, is required to inform the academy and stay home until they and/or their household contact have become symptom free and have a repeat COVID-19 test that is negative or have been symptom free for three days and it has been greater than ten days from their first symptom. Any employee who has COVID-19 like symptoms or comes in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 like symptoms is required to tell the academy and is asked to stay off campus for a minimum of 14 days

## **Evert Tennis Academy Player Screening**

Prior to being approved for participation, all players are required to complete specific requirements prior to their scheduled arrival, upon arrival and adhere to day-to-day requests.

### **Items Required and/or Recommended Prior To Arrival:**

- All players must present a negative COVID test within 7 days of arrival on campus to begin training.
- Recommend all players are only with family members for the previous week prior to arrival

### **Day-to-Day Items:**

- Daily temperature screenings will take once per day PRIOR TO REPORTING TO TRAINING.
- Players will be asked health screening questions at the start of each day.
- Hand washing and sanitizing will be required throughout the day by players, staff and coaches
- Facial coverings to be worn inside of facilities and at all times when not in the training program.

## **Evert Tennis Academy Campus Visitor Screening**

Visitor access to Evert Tennis Academy campus will continue to be limited and will continuously be reviewed and analyzed. Campus access will primarily be limited to necessary vendors, and family members of players.

- Visitors that enter Evert Tennis Academy must wear facial covering and adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Campus visitors will primarily be restricted to outside common areas of campus

## **Emergency Preparedness**

If a player has a temperature of 100.4 or above the player will not be allowed at the academy and must immediately leave the academy with parent. Player cannot return to the program for a minimum of 48 hours regardless of a fever reduction during the 48-hour period of time. Should a player be absent from the program past the 48-hour period the parent is required to update the academy and advise if additional symptoms of the COVID-19 virus have been detected. Further if COVID-19 symptoms are present the academy requires the player to be tested and receive a negative test result prior to being able to return to the academy.
